Durham, NH	Town of Durham Department of Public Works	This congressionally directed spending request would assist the Town of Durham in purchasing generators for two town water pump stations, the Durham Police Station and town public works facility. These backup generator at the water pumping station would ensure residents in Durham as well as the University of New Hampshire continue to have water in the event of a prolonged power outage.	\$543
Hampstead, NH	Hampstead Fire Department	This congressionally directed spending request would support efforts by the Town of Hampstead to renovate an existing fire station into a fully interoperable Emergency Operating Center (EOC) that will improve the town's ability to coordinate information and emergency resources.	\$200
Manchester, NH	City of Manchester Fire Department	This congressionally directed spending request would assist in providing the City of Manchester with an Emergency Operations Center (EOC) to facilitate the region's emergency and disaster response efforts.	\$5,000
