Bristol, NH	Town of Bristol	Funds from this request would support the Town of Bristol's efforts to deliver reliable broadband services to residents and local businesses who need it for telework, telemedicine, distance learning and research.	\$994
Carroll County, NH	Mt. Washington Valley Economic Council	This project supports infrastructure upgrades at the Mt. Washington Valley Technology Village Business Resource Center, including the installation of water, sewer, road and broadband networks.	\$200
Claremont, NH	City of Claremont	Funding from this request will support the installation of a fire sprinkler system in the Claremont Opera House.	\$100
Durham, NH	University of New Hampshire	This request supports a statewide initiative led by the University of New Hampshire and the New Hampshire Veterinary Diagnostics Laboratory to expand the molecular diagnostics capacity of the New England region.	\$100
Grafton County, NH	Mid-State Community Development Corporation	This project will support the renovation of an existing 8,400 square foot building in Plymouth, NH, to allow the Mid-State Community Development Corporation to better meet the needs of children and families in Grafton County.	\$200

Grafton County, NH	Society for the Protection of New Hampshire Forests	This project supports infrastructure investments at The Rocks in Grafton County, replacing a community economic and educational resource lost to fire in 2019 by renovating an existing historic barn as a net-zero forest exploration center.	\$100
Grafton County, NH	Town of Campton	This project supports the purchase and installation of 2 VHF P25 compliant interoperability Radio repeaters and the additional equipment that will be needed to operate this new system.	\$175
Grafton and Merrimack Counties, NH	Town of Bristol	Funding from this request will offset costs associated with the construction of a new 22,000 square foot public safety building in Bristol, NH.	\$75
Littleton, NH	Town of Littleton	Funding from this request will be used to offset the costs associated with the implementation of Phase II of the Littleton Main Street project, which would address a number of challenges in the area to include: re-alignment a dangerous intersection in downtown, installation of sidewalks and pedestrian walkways and additional parking.	\$100
