A BILL

5	(a) Timing for Distribution of Certain Infor-
6	MATION AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THE

8	of the Energy Conservation and Production Act (42
9	U.S.C. 6867) is amended—
10	(1) in subsection (d), by striking the subsection

16	"(2) TIMING.—On receipt of a plan adopted

21	"(2) publish the allocation of assistance to be
22	provided to States under this section in accordance
23	with the applicable distribution formula for the fiscal
24	year, including pursuant to subsection (b).

- 1 "(g) Timing of Payments.—On receipt of a State
- 2 energy conservation plan submitted under section 362, the
- 3 Secretary shall distribute funds to a State as quickly as
- 4 practicable.".
