I write in support of the application submitted by White Mountains Community College (WMCC) for funding from the Rural Postsecondary and Economic Development Grant Program. Federal investment will enable WMCC and its partner – Campus Compact for New Hampshire (CCNH) – to implement their North Country Persistence and Continuing Education (PACE) Program and improve postsecondary success for rural students in northern New Hampshire.
