4	(a) ELIGIBILITY EXPANSION.—Section 3701(b) of
5	title 38, United States Code, is amended by adding at the
6	end the following new paragraph:
7	"(8) The term 'veteran' also includes, for the
8	purposes of home loans, an individual who, for a pe-
9	riod of not less than 90 consecutive days, performed
10	active duty for training—
11	"(A) described in subparagraph (A) or (E)
12	of paragraph (22) of section 101 of this title;
13	"(B) other than basic training, as such
14	term is used in sections 7419, 8431, and 9419
15	of title 10; and
16	"(C) on or after the day that is six years
17	before the date of the enactment of the Ex-
18	panding Home Loans for Guard and Reservists
19	Act.".
20	(b) ENTITLEMENT TO HOUSING LOAN.—Section
21	3702(a)(2) of such title is amended by adding at the end
22	the following new subparagraph:
23	"(H) Each individual described in section
24	3701(b)(8) of this title.".
